**GOVERNMENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR LEAVE OF COURT TO
DISMISS THE INDICTMENT AND VACATE ORDER OF DETENTION**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 48(a), the government respectfully moves for leave to dismiss the indictment (*see* dkt. 1) against defendant Narasimha Bhogavalli without prejudice. The government has conferred with counsel for Bhogavalli and represents that the relief requested herein is unopposed. The government further asks this Court to vacate the Order of Detention (dkt. 8) entered on October 28, 2016, remanding Bhogavalli to the custody of the Attorney General and United States Marshal and asks for his immediate release.


